

LEATHER -

Clean weekly with a light damp cloth to prevent build up of dirt and dust. Avoid using any harsh cleaning agents and allow to dry out of direct sunlight to avoid warping the material. Leather of this type may become dry after prolonged periods of time - to increase its longevity it is recommended to avoid very hot/dry areas and to condition annually with Wax/Oil pull up type polishes.

Water based stains/light spills should be gently dabbed with a dry cloth as soon as possible. Avoid hard rubbing as this may warp the surface. Difficult stains should be removed by professional cleaners - if that is unsuitable, treat the stain with diluted leather soap. Test the cleaning agent on an inconspicuous area first.

VEGAN LEATHER -

Clean weekly with a soft colourfast cloth to prevent build up of dirt and dust. Water based stains/light spills should be cleaned with a clean colourfast cloth using a solution of mild soap and clean water. Avoid hard rubbing as this may warp the surface. Difficult stains should be cautiously removed by blotting a solution of 25% Isopropyl Alcohol and water. Test the cleaning agent on an inconspicuous area first as indiscriminate use of any solvent, or cleaning agents containing solvents, can severely damage or discolour the material.

After use of any cleaning products the material must be wiped clean of any residual products. Use fresh water and a clean cloth before wiping dry. Detergents should never be used on a regular basis for normal cleaning, and the presence of residual cleaning product may cause deterioration of the vinyl over time.

VINYL -

Clean weekly with a soft colourfast cloth to prevent buildup of dirt and dust. Water based stains/light spills should be cleaned with a clean colourfast cloth using a solution of mild soap and clean water. Moderate scrubbing with a medium bristle brush will help loosen soiling materials from the depressions of embossed surfaces. Difficult stains should be cautiously removed by a mild detergent. As a last solution - blotting a solution of 25% Isopropyl Alcohol and water on the stain may be tried. Test the cleaning agent on an inconspicuous area first as indiscriminate use of any solvent, or cleaning agents containing solvents, can severely damage or discolour the material.

After the use of any cleaning products the material must be wiped clean of any residual products. Use fresh water and a clean cloth before wiping dry. Detergents should never be used on a regular basis for normal cleaning, and the presence of residual cleaning product may cause deterioration of the vinyl over time.

VELVET - [Fibreguard]

Vacuum weekly with an upholstery attachment to prevent build up of dirt and dust. Accidental stains can be removed by applying water to the stain and blotting with a white paper towel. Avoid rubbing as this will deposit fibres from the paper towel into the fabric. Repeat until the stain no longer appears on the paper towel. Stubborn stains may be removed with a colourfast microfibre cloth and a small amount of standard, white, household soap.

Leave to air dry as any heat may warp the material and lock in the stain.
